



Cancer of Penis

Carcinoma of the penis is an uncommon lesion, which may present as an ulcer which continues to be a problem.

The usual causes of these lesions are phimosis, bacterial infections, inflammations for a range of reasons and venereal diseases. They can also be associated with being uncircumcised but we have also seen these in circumcised patients.

Diagnosis and treatment

A small lesion may be excised locally and this may clear up the problem completely, allowing for normal recoveries. In some cases however, there may be further issues and a reconstruction may be necessary for the patient.
